



PIP Meeting Minutes, March 8, 2013

LA Harbor College paired PIP to their new FYE program. FYE meetings incorporate PIP stuff. FYE has 70 students and students took Art & English 28 \* PD 17 Service Learning. Math is left out because it is a prerequisite for the Eng 28. All students are taking the appropriate Math level being placed by counselors.

2 sections of English 28, Service Learning and PD 17. All Instructors taught the FYE English and non FYE and the FYE students have a completion of 81.9% over 61.3%. These FYE students are also going to English 101 into the next level with the same instructor.

Spring 2013 English 101, History 11 with the same exact cohort. Options Music, Speech and Health 11. Harbor had an Enrollment Fair to help students get their courses. Retention is about 80% with the FYE students. Their counselor is still working with them. Counselor works with students to create their Student Educational Plans.

Students created the Student Success Society club group.

Part of our provisional project is the PIP for faculty. This is their version of the Faculty Academy. Part of their FYE is from AtD.

### **East LA College**

- FYE: \$500,000 for this year and \$1 Million for the following year for the First Year Completion Model. 300 Hours are English, Math And PD courses and 100 hours for elective course. Riff came when we went to the counselors and Matriculation. This is 10% of serving students (N=450 Students) from the 4000 students every Fall. Complete enrich for open to all students. Picked the courses on evidence and made a grid of courses, transferable to CSU/UC, Degree, CTE course, and Notes.
- Divided we Fail, we need 20 units to complete. Looked at this model as research to move forward with this program.
- Chart is color coordinated the courses and student support services and they see this is link.

- English will be aligned with 21, 28 and 101. They will get rid of English 26. Winter 2014 is meant for a make-up if they haven't done well in the previous semester.
